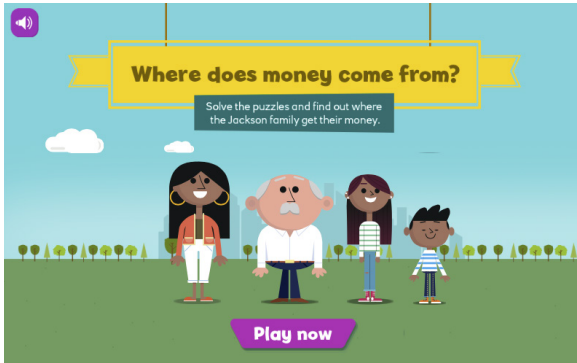


Where does money come from?

Guide to interactive activity



Introduction

The interactive activity **Where does money come from?** introduces the Jackson family. Your child will complete puzzles to help them learn about the different ways the family earns its money.

This interactive activity will support your child in learning where people get their money from and in understanding about working to earn money.

Guide

If your child is able or would like to practise their reading skills, they can read each instruction aloud. They can also use the sound button to help or confirm the written text.

Your child will be introduced to the characters in the Jackson family:

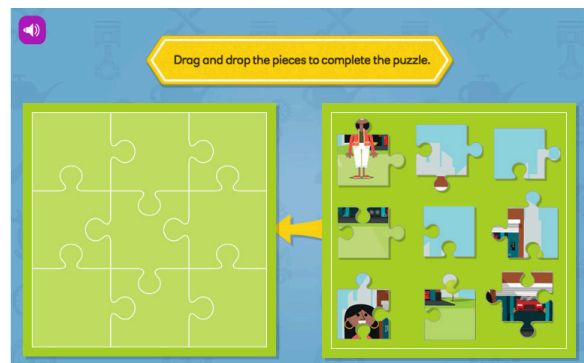
- Priya Jackson (mum)
- Sam Jackson (grandad)
- Lara Jackson (child and sister to Amir)
- Amir Jackson (child and brother to Lara)

Let your child pick the family member they would most like to begin with. They will get to work through the others later.

Your child will need to move the puzzle pieces into the correct place so that they can find out how the family member earns their money. Before beginning ask your child what job they think each character might do to earn money and what they may spend the money on.

When completing the puzzle, ask your child how they will work out where each puzzle piece goes. Encourage them to look for clues e.g. flat on the top side, no flat sides, etc.

When all puzzles have been completed, talk with your child about the jobs that they are aware of and what they would like to work as when they are older. If your child gets pocket money you may want to discuss the tasks they could carry out to earn their pocket money.



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
